## DEFERRED DISPOSITION INSTRUCTIONS FOR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS

**READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY** - Failure to do so will void your request.

Code of Criminal Procedure Article 45.051

Suspension of Sentence and Deferral of Final Disposition

- 1) The defendant must enter a plea of no contest or guilty and make a request to the Court for Deferred Disposition.
- 2) The request must be made by the due date on the ticket.
- 3) If you are 24 years of age or under and request Deferred Disposition, you will be required to attend a Driver's Safety Course.
- 4) You are not eligible for Deferred Disposition if you hold a CDL (Commercial Driver's License)
- 5) You are not eligible if you were speeding 25 or more miles over the speed limit. Please contact the court.
- 6) The fee for Deferred Disposition is \$50 and is in addition to the fine amount.
- 7) When a request is made to the Court in a timely manner and all requirements are met the defendant will be granted deferred disposition.
