- The Judge and Clerks are prohibited from providing legal advice or assisting in filling out forms.
- If you are a Pro Se Litigant (Not represented by an Attorney), it is your responsibility to be
 familiar with the laws that govern Writs of Restoration. A copy of The Texas Property Code (Sec
 92.008 covers residential and Sec. 93.002 covers commercial) is provided in our office for your
 review during normal business hours. You may also access the links on our website co.tyler.tx.us
 under Justice of the Peace page. The Court CANNOT assist you with your case. Utilize the
 resources provided.
- You must provide the court with the original, a copy for your records, and 1 copy per defendant (if 2 defendants will be served, then you must provide a copy for each of them) of all documents filed with the court.
- You cannot discuss your case with the Judge outside of the hearing. Make sure you bring all evidence supporting your case to the hearing.
- We accept filings Monday thru Friday from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm
- The Constable does NOT serve Out of County Citations. Please notify the clerk if the Party you are suing will not be served in Tyler County.
- If your suit is settled out of court and you no longer wish to come to your hearing, please file it in writing with the Court. You may use the form for Non Suit located on our website if you wish.
