General Description

Handles routine and emergency radio, telephone, and 911 calls for service following special or written instructions for transmitting and routing calls for Law Enforcement, Fire, and Medical Services. Dispatches patrol deputies to calls for service and enters accurate and concise data into the Computer Aided Dispatch System. Coordinates with external emergency services when needed for augmented response. Occasionally conducts jail operations, including searching of incoming inmates.

Minimum Qualifications

- Must have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Must successfully complete the Field Training Program.
- Must successfully pass pre-employment background investigation.
- Must be willing and able to work 12 hours shifts, including evenings, nights, weekends, and holidays.
- Skill in handling multiple tasks, prioritizing, and meeting deadlines.
- Ability to listen and communicate effectively.
- Ability to remain calm and function appropriately during stressful situations.
- Ability to receive and respond positively to constructive feedback.
