General Description

Responsible for the protection of life and property, prevention of crime, apprehension of criminals, and enforcement of laws in Tyler County. Includes patrol, traffic regulation, initial and follow-up investigation, civil process, and special assignments. Work involves an element of personal danger and requires the ability to act without direct supervision and to exercise independent judgment in meeting complex emergency situations. Work assignments and instructions are received from a supervisor who reviews work methods and results through reports, observation, and discussion.

Minimum Qualifications

- Must be willing to relocate to Tyler County, Texas.
- Must have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Must be a certified Texas Peace Officer in good standing with the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Must successfully complete the Field Training Program.
- Must successfully pass required firearms qualification.
- Must successfully pass pre-employment background investigation.
- Knowledge of the Texas Penal Code, Code of Criminal Procedure, and other state and federal statutes.
- Must be willing and able to work 12 hours shifts, including evenings, nights, weekends, and holidays.
- Skilled in handling multiple tasks, prioritizing, and meeting deadlines.
- Skilled in effective oral and written communication.
- Skilled in exercising sound judgment and effective decision making.
- Ability to receive and respond positively to constructive feedback.
