NOTICE

RESCINDING ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

While expressing serious concerns regarding the amount of accumulated debris to be burned, the Tyler County Commissioners Court determined that the received and projected amounts of precipitation provided a window of opportunity for rescinding the Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning. Therefore, **the Burn Ban in Tyler County will be lifted today, November 22nd, at 12:00 NOON.** Recognizing that Tyler County remains designated by the Texas Forest Service as a drought area, the Court requests that this fact be kept in consideration when burning. The Court will convene Monday, November 28th at 8:30 AM for the purpose of reevaluating the conditions.
