Commissioner Marshall presiding as Judge Pro-Tem called the meeting to order. Commissioner Sturrock delivered the invocation and then led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to seek bids for **Debris Management** during a disaster declaration. **Commissioner Sturrock** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** and seconded by **Commissioner Hudson** to appoint Glen Conner to the **Tyler County Hospital Board of Managers**, replacing Cody Jarrott. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hudson** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to update the **County Policy** to include the required sexual orientation changes to the EEO and harassment sections to be compliant with federal regulations. The County Treasurer read aloud the changes. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sturrock** and seconded by **Commissioner Hudson** to approve the purchase of eFile integration for \$2500 and purchase of four scanners at \$1134 each for the **District Clerk's office**. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Blacksher** and seconded by **Commissioner Hudson** to accept the **County Treasurer's Quarterly Investment Report** from April. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED
