#### **Proposed Regulation of Subdivisions of Land, Including Manufactured Home Rental Communities Pursuant to §232 of the Texas Local Government Code**

#### **I. PUBLIC COMMENTS**

*Members of the public are encouraged to speak either to their Commissioner or the County Judge regarding matters of their concern. The public is invited to attend all meetings of the commissioners Court except Executive Sessions. Public participation is limited to that of an observer UNLESS:*

- 1) a member(s) of the public is requested to address the Court on a particular issue(s); or*
- 2) a member(s) of the public completes a **Public Comment Participation Form** and submits it to the county Clerk **prior** to the **CALL TO ORDER** of the Court. Public comment Participation Forms will be available prior to the start of court from the county Clerk, County Judge's office, or on the county website ( [www.co.tyler.tx.us](http://www.co.tyler.tx.us) ). Each member of the public who appears before the Commissioners shall be limited to a maximum of five (5) minutes to make his/her remarks. Discussion on any specific topic will be restricted to 30 minutes, total, for all speakers on that to comment. Time for each speaker shall be maintained by the County Clerk or such other designated representative of the Commissioners' Court.*

**The County of Tyler will hold a public hearing at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, July 20, 2021 in the Justice of the Peace Courtroom, located at 203 W. Dogwood, Woodville, Texas 75979, in regard to the Proposed Regulation of Subdivisions, including manufactured home rental communities.**

**The purpose of this meeting is to allow citizens an opportunity to discuss the proposed Regulation of Subdivisions of Land and to state their views. The county of Tyler encourages citizens to make their views known at the public hearing. Citizens unable to attend, may submit their views and proposals to Jacques L.
