**MANDATORY CURFEW ORDER, 10PM-6AM**  
**Hurricane Laura Event, Effective August 26, 2020**

WHEREAS, Tyler County, Texas, expects to suffer severe damage as a result of **Hurricane Laura** and the natural elements, thus necessitating immediate protection against further loss; and,

WHEREAS, a curfew between the hours of **10PM through 6AM effective AUGUST 26, 2020** preventing persons without proper authority from being upon the public streets or rights-of-way located within Tyler County will greatly assist law enforcement in protection against further loss; and

**NOW THEREFORE, I, COUNTY JUDGE OF TYLER COUNTY, HEREBY FIND AND ORDER:**

SECTION 1: That the findings and recitations set out in the preamble to this ORDER are found to be true and correct and they are hereby adopted and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2: That it shall be unlawful for any person, without proper authority, to be upon the public streets or rights-of-way located within Tyler County **between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. until this order is lifted.**

SECTION 3. That the Tyler County Sheriff is hereby authorized to designate other areas and to restrict access, ingress and egress to those areas, as warranted by circumstances.

SECTION 4. That it shall be unlawful for any person, **without proper authority**, to be in an affected area that has been designated with limited or denied access, ingress, or egress and any person or entity who shall violate any provision of this ORDER shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in a sum not to exceed \$1,000.00. Each unauthorized entry into a designated, restricted area shall constitute a separate violation.

SECTION 5. That this ORDER shall expire upon the order of the Tyler County Judge.

SECTION 6. That, in accordance with the Texas Disaster Act, this order shall take effect immediately at 10:00P.M. on August 26, 2020.
