DRIVER'S SAFETY COURSE INFORMATION

YOU MUST CONTACT THE COURT TO REQUEST DRIVERS SAFETY COURSE PRIOR TO TAKING THE COURSE

DRIVING SAFETY COURSE (DSC, DEFENSIVE DRIVING) INFORMATION

READ INSTRUCTUCTIONS CAREFULLY – Failure to do so will void your request.

CCP 45.0511(A)(1) - (3), the Court shall defer proceedings and allow you 90 days to present evidence that subsequent to the alleged offense, you have successfully completed a DRIVING SAFETY COURSE approved by the Texas Department of Public Safety, IF:

- You have NOT taken a Driving Safety Course for dismissal of a traffic citation within the last 12 months and submit the sworn affidavit stating so.
- 2. You must have a valid Texas Driver's License or Permit.
- 3. You must have current automobile insurance.
- 4. Do NOT hold a Commercial Driver's License (CDL).

You are NOT eligible for DSC if:

You were charged with the offense of:

- Speeding 25 MPH or more over the posted speed limit
- Driving a speed of 95 miles per hour or higher
- Passing a School Bus
- Moving Violation in a Construction Zone with Workers present
- Hit and Run (leaving the scene of an Accident with damage to a vehicle)
- Fleeing (Failure to give information/render aid)

If the Court grants DSC, you must provide the court on or before your appearance date with;

Enter a Plea of Nolo Contendere (No Contest) or Guilty
Copy of your Driver's License
Current Proof of Insurance
Notarized Affidavit (stating you have not taken DSC in the last 12 months)
Driving Record – Type 3A (can be obtained from the DPS at www.dps.texas.gov
Payment in the amount of \$144.00 (DO NOT MAKE PAYMENT UNTIL DSC HAS
BEEN APPROVED BY THE COURT AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN
DECEIVED BY THE COLIDT)

^{***}Failure to provide the Court with <u>any or all</u> of the above requirements will result in additional fines and fees and a warrant may be issued***
