DECLARATION OF DISASTER

JULY 8, 2024


WHEREAS, on the 8th day of **July**, Tyler County, Texas was in imminent threat of the occurrence of widespread and/or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from severe weather conditions countywide created by Hurricane Beryl. Reports by the United States National Weather Service, Texas Division of Emergency Management State Operations Center, and our local meteorologists, Beryl has the potential to cause torrential rainfall, flash flooding, high sustained high winds with higher gusts, severe thunderstorms and tornadic activity over an extensive period of time affecting Tyler County by causing flooding, wind damage and major damage to infrastructure preventing access to, or the safe passage on, many roadways as well as the potential for widespread residential and commercial electrical power and utility outage. Such conditions will cause a public safety hazard; and

WHEREAS, the Tyler County Judge has determined, based upon forecasts issued by the National Weather Service and local news media outlets, extraordinary measures must be taken to protect life, as well as protect or rehabilitate property, and are hereby ordered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a local state of disaster for public health emergency is hereby declared for Tyler County, Texas pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster for shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Tyler County, Texas.
3. Pursuant to section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Tyler County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Tyler County Emergency Management Plan.
5. This declaration shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
