DISASTER DECLARATION

Fire Event

WHEREAS, the County of Tyler, on the 25th day of August, 2023, is in threat of damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from conditions created by fires affecting Tyler County. Such conditions create a public safety hazard.


WHEREAS, as Tyler County Judge, I have determined, based upon trajectory reports issued by multiple Emergency Management Organization, that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect life, as well as protect or rehabilitate property; and are hereby ordered.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF TYLER COUNTY:

- That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Tyler County, Texas pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code;
- Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Tyler County, Texas;
- Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Tyler County Clerk.
- Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Tyler County Emergency Management Plan.

EFFECTIVE this 25th day of August, 2023, from and after its issuance.
